## LG performs aarti at restored Vasudev Ghat

New Delhi: Delhi Development Authority on Tuesday opened its first restored ghat along the river Yamuna, Vasudev Ghat, for public. Lieutenant governor VK Saxena inaugurated the place and performed aarti in the evening.

Spread over 16 hectare, the main ghat stretches to a length of 145m and has 25 steps to the holy water of Yamuna. "The authority has got silt removed from the banks for the convenience of visitors coming to this place. The place has five-hectare greens restored and developed in Chabagh style," stated DDA. "Not just this ghat, DDA is also trying to revive entire Ya-

muna floodplains and other ghats in Delhi by restoring them. I am quite confident that with this, not only will the banks of Yamuna get back its old form, but people will also get a pleasant feeling by coming here. However, to maintain the sanctity of this place, we should also take responsibility in the conservation of Yamuna," Saxena said. Other attractions adorning the site included a statue of Maa Yamuna amidst beautifully carved pavilions and lush green lawns with flowerbeds sown thematically every season. DDA has entered an MoU with a registered society for organising 'Yamuna Aarti' at Vasudev Ghat regularly and maintaining associated amenities.



# Killer Drug Fraud On Cancer Patients

## 7 Men Held For Selling Fake Injections By Refilling Used Vials

New Delhi: Delhi Police's crime branch has unearthed a massive racket of manufacturing and selling of counterfeit cancer and chemotherapy drugs with the arrest of 7 persons. The syndicate, police said, played with people's lives by providing fake medicines with no active ingredients.

Special commissioner (crime) Shalini Singh said the police had seized spurious medicines with labels of seven international and two Indian brands worth Rs 4 crore, besides empty vials, packaging material and machinery from the accused. "Two of the accused work in a hospital. Their duty was to dispose of empty vials after the cancer medicine was used, but they sold these to associates who then refilled these and supplied for sale," the special CP said.

The vials, filled with random and cheap medicines, were sold at exorbitant rates. The gang spent around Rs 150-200 on each vial of an expensive injection and sold these in the market for anything between Rs 1-3 lakh, depending on the brand that was refilled.

Police suspect that the gang targeted over 200 cancer patients and are in the process of tracing them. Their statements will be recorded. "A few people became nervous and hopeless after hearing they were taking drugs which were spurious. It will take time for them to settle down, their statements will be recorded," another officer said.

The mobile phones of the accused have been sent for forensic testing to recover deleted chats and files. "We haven't found any register, so we suspect they might have kept client records on their phones," the officer said. "With the money they earned, they purchased apartments and shops worth crores, and invested in various places," a police officer said. The police have found out that the network spanned several states. Delhi-NCR, Uttar Pradesh and Bihar are among these. Te-

## How pharmacists & frauds ran the racket from 2 W Delhi flats

New Delhi: Nestled in the upscale DLF Greens in west Delhi's Moti Nagar, the two flats betrayed no sign of unusual activity. However, investigators were shocked at the scale of operations going on towards the manufacturing of fake cancer and chemotherapy drugs.

Special commissioner Shalini Singh said a crime branch probe revealed how people from various fields had formed a nexus to target patients, not just from Delhi and neighbouring states but other countries too.

A key player, she said, was Viphil Jain from Baghpat, who ran the show in Moti Nagar. Having spent his childhood in Seelampur, he quit studies before finishing Class X. "After failing to finish basic education, he started dedicating his time at a medical store in Seelampur as a store boy. Initially, he started supplying medicines from wholesale markets to local medical stores," Singh said.

A few years ago, he happened to discuss the idea of refilling cancer injections as these were expensive. Falling in the life-saving drug category, selling fake injections could fetch big money, he believed. He chose expensive injection brands and involved two friends — Parvez and Neeraj Chauhan — to arrange for empty vials and supply the refilled ones.

Jain allegedly used to fill the vials with Fluconazole, an anti-fungal drug.

Chauhan was also from Baghpat and a graduate. He tried his hand at medical transcription and later was a manager in oncology departments of hospitals in Delhi and Gurgaon between 2006 and 2022.

In 2022, Chauhan joined Jain and helped grow his business

exponentially. With his experience in the medical sector, he got clients by luring them with "chemo injections" at affordable rates. "Chauhan also ran a company for medical tourism and targeted those who came to India for cancer treatment... Chauhan's cousin, Tushar, was a lab technician and helped him in supplying injections in Bhagirath Place and other markets.

The third person arrested is Parvez, an ex-pharmacist who worked in a reputed cancer hospital in Delhi. He was running a pharmacy shop called Doctor Pharmacy in partnership with Komal Tiwari, police said.

"Parvez earlier worked in a mixing unit of chemotherapy medicines at a reputed hospital, where the customer or the hospital used to give him medicines and injections for mixing with other medicines. He engaged Komal and Abhinay Kohli, working with reputed hospitals, to provide empty vials," the officer added. Komal was a pharmacist at a cytotoxic admixture unit of a cancer hospital in Delhi since 2013. He supplied empty vials to Parvez for Rs 5,000 each. Kohli too was a pharmacist in the same unit as Komal. He also supplied vials.

An accused, named Suraj from West Bengal, was the caretaker of the flats.

New Delhi: The National Commission For Protection of Child Rights (NCPDR) chief Priyanka Kanoongo and other dignitaries were in for a shock when they found two underage boys who claimed to be below 18 years serving lunch, clearing dishes and handling trash during a lunch at a function organised by the commission to mark its foundation day at the prestigious India Habitat Centre in New Delhi.

The commission has issued a notice to Delhi Police to register an FIR against the management of IHC and the contractor for allegedly enaging

underage boys in violation of the provisions of the child labour laws. The commission has sought an action taken report within three days.

Speaking to TOI, NCPDR chief Priyanka Kanoongo said, "A thorough investigation is required as to how these boys were engaged in violation of the labour law provisions. Also these boys are evidently putting in long hours beyond those permitted for the boys in the above 14 and under 18 category. Moreover, they are school dropouts and there seems to have been no attempt to connect them to education."

Late in the night, India Habitat Centre issued a statement

denying any violation of law at their end. "We have copies of the Aadhaar cards of both persons with dates of birth that show that they are both above 18 years of age," IHC claimed.

"Please note that IHC has a policy of strict compliance with labour and children-related laws. As a standard operating procedure, the ID proofs of

all our contractual staff are checked before permitting them to work at the Centre," the statement emphasised. "IHC takes such matters very seriously. All our systems are in adherence with govt rules and regulations and we comply with them with all sincerity," it stated.

In a notice addressed to the deputy commissioner of police (south), NCPDR has stated that while celebrating its foundation day at Jacaranda Hall in IHC, the dignitaries were served lunch by two underage boys aged around 17, who were seen picking up the used utensils as well as the waste material.

According to the notice, the team of child labour de-

partment and NCPDR spoke to the boys and they themselves have admitted that they are under 18. One of the boys was engaged by the contractor for the last 15-20 days and both were engaged by IHC through the contractor based on the date of birth mentioned in their Aadhar card. Police were called and they were asked to register a case and produce the children before the child welfare committee for further probe.

"You are requested to lodge an FIR against the management of IHC and the contractor involved in engaging minor children in child labour situation," NCPDR has said in its notice to police.

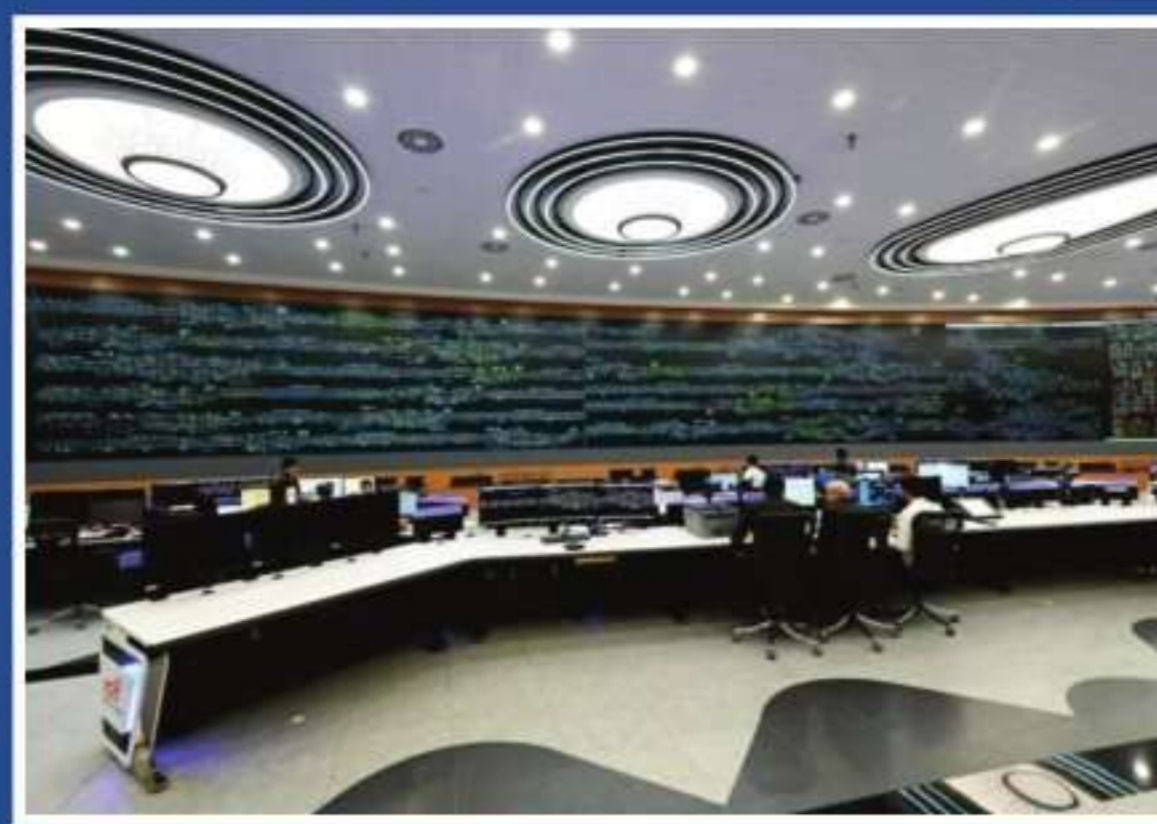

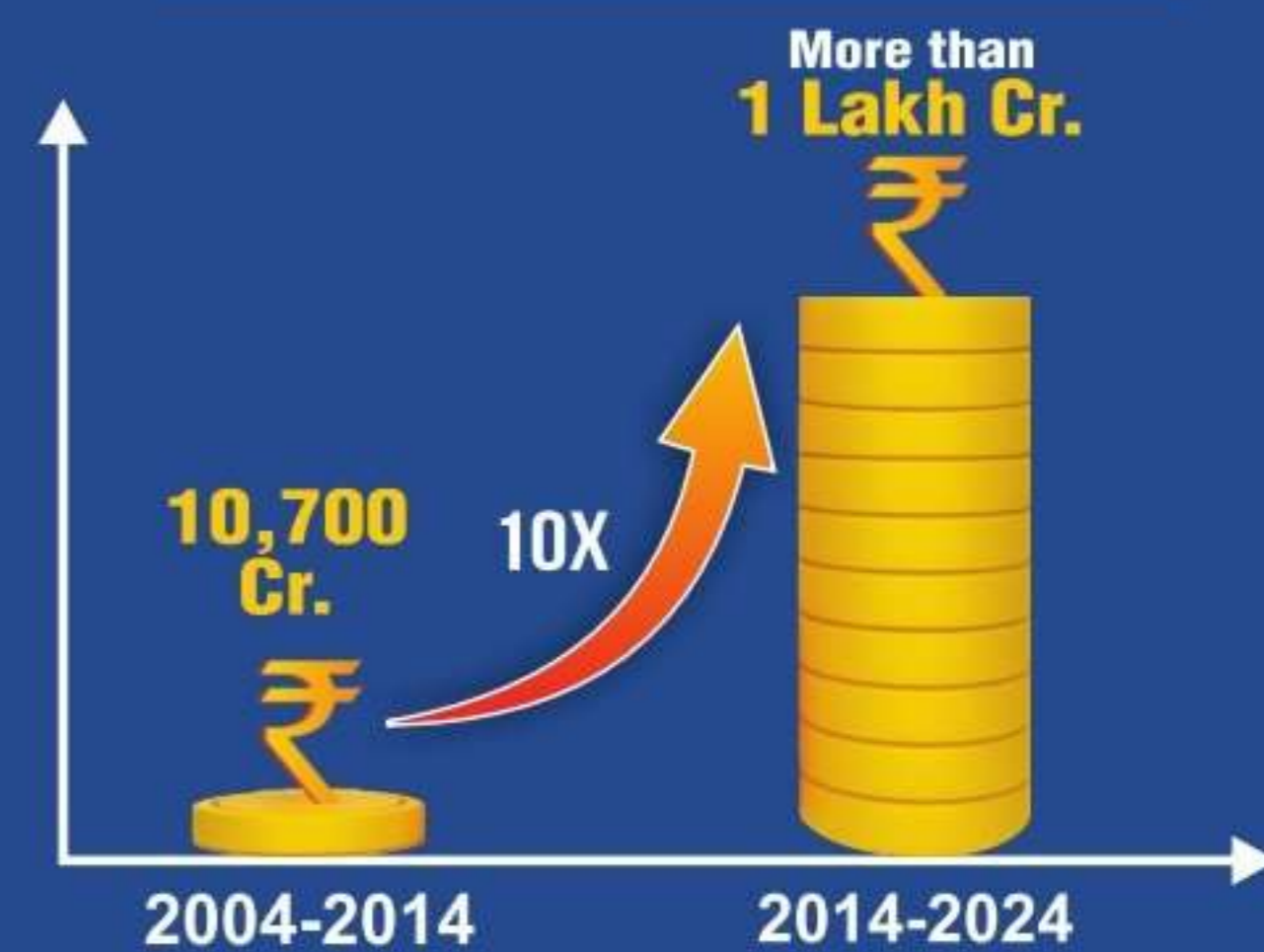

## SC says give Kerala a bailout, govt expresses reservations

**Centre: Can't Discriminate Among States**

**New Delhi:** As Kerala govt is facing extreme fiscal problems due to the Centre's decision to put a cap on its borrowing capacity, the Supreme Court on Tuesday asked the Union govt to consider a bailout package as a one-time measure with a condition that the amount given could be adjusted in the first quarter of the next financial year.

A bench of Justices Surya Kant and K V Viswanathan asked the Centre to be liberal and give some concession and clarified that the Centre would beat liberty to put stringent conditions on the state for the next financial year.

However, additional solicitor general N Venkataraman expressed the Centre's reservation in extending special treatment to Kerala saying that the Centre had rejected similar pleas of bail-out packages made by other states. He said that govt was "literally handicapped" and it could not discriminate among states.



**CAP ON BORROWING**

The court asked govt to explore all possibilities and brief the court on Wednesday. It was hearing a petition filed by the state against the Centre's decision to impose limits on the state's borrowing capacity. The court had earlier asked both govt to sit together and sort out the issue through dialogue.

The Centre and Kerala are at loggerheads with the state approaching SC contending that the Centre's decision was against fiscal federalism. Kerala govt in its suit referred to Centre's letters dated March 27, 2023, and Aug 11, 2023 through the finance ministry (public finance-state division), department of expenditure, and amendments made to Sec 4 of Fiscal Responsibility & Budget Management Act, 2003. ### Kerala mum on MLA plea, draws SC rap

**S**upreme Court Tuesday pulled up Kerala govt for not filing its reply on a plea by MLA Antony Raju against the initiation of fresh criminal proceedings in the infamous underwear evidence tampering case. A bench of Justices C T Ravikumar and Rajesh Bindal observed, "Why have you not replied? Is it because you are hand-in-glove with the accused?"

The case against Raju arose around 33 years ago when a lawyer he was representing an Australian national Andrew Salvatore Cervelli who was arrested for allegedly smuggling 61.5 grams of charas by concealing it in his underwear. Cervelli was convicted and sentenced to 10 years imprisonment and he challenged the order in HC which acquitted him as it was found that the underwear was too small in size to fit Cervelli. A criminal complaint was then registered against Raju and a court clerk in 1994 for tampering with evidence. **TNN**

## Why didn't you act since 2021 on I-T demand, HC asks Cong

**New Delhi:** Delhi high court Tuesday reserved its verdict on a plea by Congress challenging tax recovery proceedings, but wondered why the party had taken no step since 2021, when the demand was first raised.

We respect India's territorial authority, but also respect rule of law, says NZ deputy PM Peters

**New Delhi:** Walking the diplomatic tightrope in the India-Canada diplomatic spat over the killing of a Khalistan separatist in Canada, visiting New Zealand deputy PM and foreign minister Winston Peters told **TOI** Tuesday that the South Pacific country respects the rule of law as much as India's territorial integrity.

New Zealand is part of the Five Eyes alliance whose shared intelligence, according to the US, informed Canadian PM Justin Trudeau allegations about Indian involvement in the killing of Hardeep Singh Nijjar last year in Vancouver. In the middle of growing concerns over expanding Chinese presence in the Pacific Islands, Peters also welcomed India's efforts to shore up ties with

countries in the region.

"We respect India's territorial authority, but we also respect the rule of law. It's not our spat. We are not a part of this. But if you ask us where we are on the rule of law, we are defenders of it. If you ask us where we are on sovereignty, land area sovereignty, we are totally believers in it," Peters said ahead of his meeting with his counterpart S Jaishankar. As the two countries look to ramp up defence and security ties, Peters is al-

so expected to meet NSA Ajit Doval Wednesday.

While the US and UK, also members of Five Eyes, have publicly called upon India to cooperate with the Canadian probe into the Nijjar murder, this is one of the rare occasions that New Zealand has spoken on the issue. In fact, the only public remark so far had come in Sept last year, shortly after Canada's allegation against India, from then foreign minister Nanaia Mahuta who said "if the claims were proven true, that would be of serious concern".

Peters described as encouraging India's growing involvement in the Pacific Islands, while calling China's outburst against the first Australia-New Zealand 2+2 dialogue earlier this year, in which New Zealand had indicated it might join the non-nuclear pillar of AUKUS, surprising.

## US and UN express concern about CAA

**Washington:** The US govt and the United Nations on Tuesday expressed concerns about the Citizenship (Amendment) Act 2019, with the UN calling the legislation "fundamentally discriminatory in nature."

"As we said in 2019, we are concerned that CAA is fundamentally discriminatory in nature and in breach of India's international human rights obligations," a spokesperson of the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights told Reuters. He added the office was studying whether the law's implementation rules comply with international human rights law.

The US has also signalled reservations. "We are concerned about the notification of CAA on March

11. We are closely monitoring how this act will be implemented," a state department spokesperson told Reuters separately. "Respect for religious freedom and equal treatment under the law for all communities are fundamental democratic principles," the spokesperson added.

The Indian embassy in Washington did not immediately respond to a request for comment on the state department and the UN human rights office reactions.

The Indian government denies the law is anti-Muslim and says it was needed to help minorities facing persecution in neighboring Muslim-majority nations. It has called the earlier protests politically motivated. **REUTERS**

## India slams China over Arunachal

**New Delhi:** India on Tuesday slammed China for objecting to PM Modi's Arunachal Pradesh visit, reiterating that the state is and will remain an integral and inalienable part of India. The Chinese side has been made aware of this consistent position on several occasions, the foreign ministry said.

"We reject the comments made by the Chinese side regarding the visit of the PM to Arunachal Pradesh. Indian leaders visit Arunachal Pradesh from time to time, as they visit other states of India," said MEA, adding that objecting to such visits or India's developmental projects does not stand to reason.

China claims Arunachal Pradesh as 'South Tibet' and routinely objects to Indian leaders' visits to the state. **TNN**

## SBI complies with SC order on electoral bonds, sends list of buyers and parties to poll panel

**Mumbai:** A day after being pulled up by Supreme Court, State Bank of India on Tuesday submitted the list of buyers of electoral bonds and the parties that have deposited them with the Election Commission.

The poll panel confirmed that SBI had submitted data on electoral bonds to it on Tuesday. "In compliance of SC's directions to SBI, contained in its order dated Feb 15 and March 11, 2024, data on electoral bonds has been supplied by SBI to the Election

Commission of India today," the panel said.

The court had directed the bank's chairman to file the information along with an affidavit. SBI did not respond to queries from **TOI**.

The public sector bank has sold electoral bonds

through 29 branches in states. Although the bank allocates a serial number for bookkeeping, these bearer instruments make it difficult to ascertain the transaction between the buyer and the depositor, sources said.

The bank had earlier informed the court that 22,217 electoral bonds were used to make donations to various political parties and that redeemed bonds were deposited in the Mumbai main branch by other authorised branches in sealed envelopes.

Although the objective of the now scrapped bonds was

to ensure anonymity, the bank was required to comply with money laundering norms and maintain a record of entities from whom funds went into the bond purchase account.

According to the FAQs on electoral bonds currently on SBI's website, the bonds had a validity of 15 days from the date of issue and could be redeemed only by an eligible political party by depositing it in their designated bank account. They could be purchased by an individual, a Hindu Undivided Family, (HUF), a company, a firm, an association or any agency.

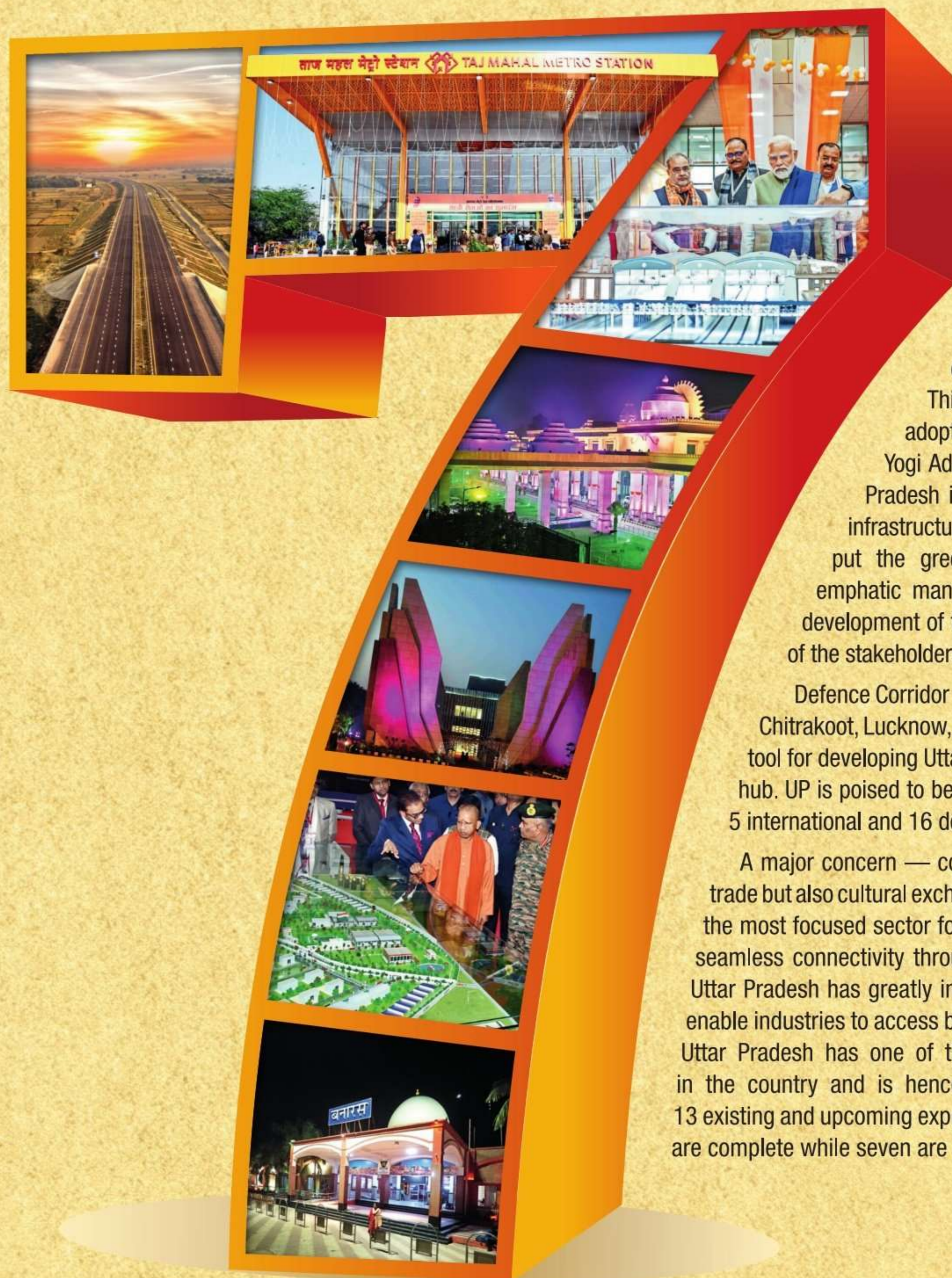

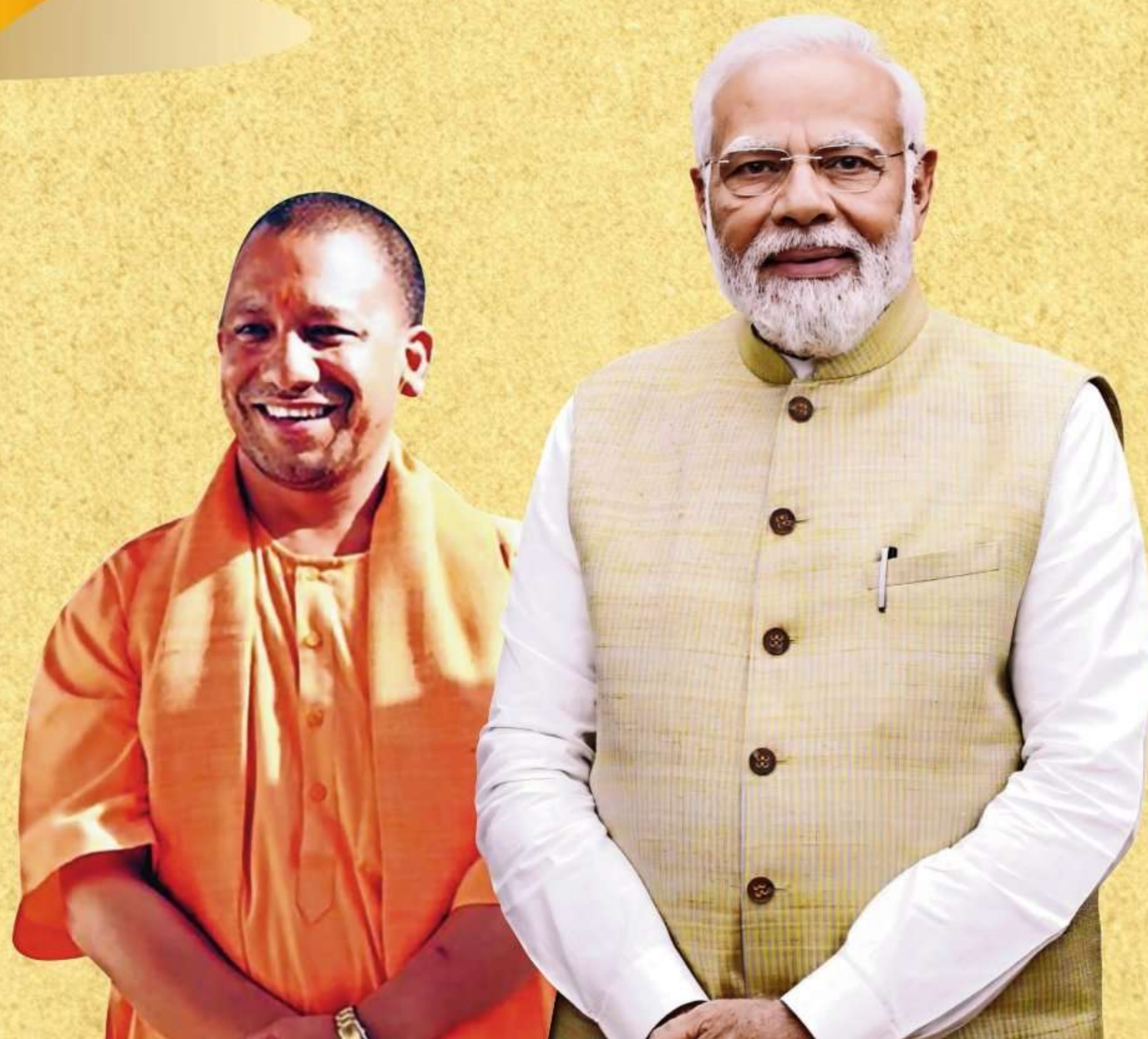

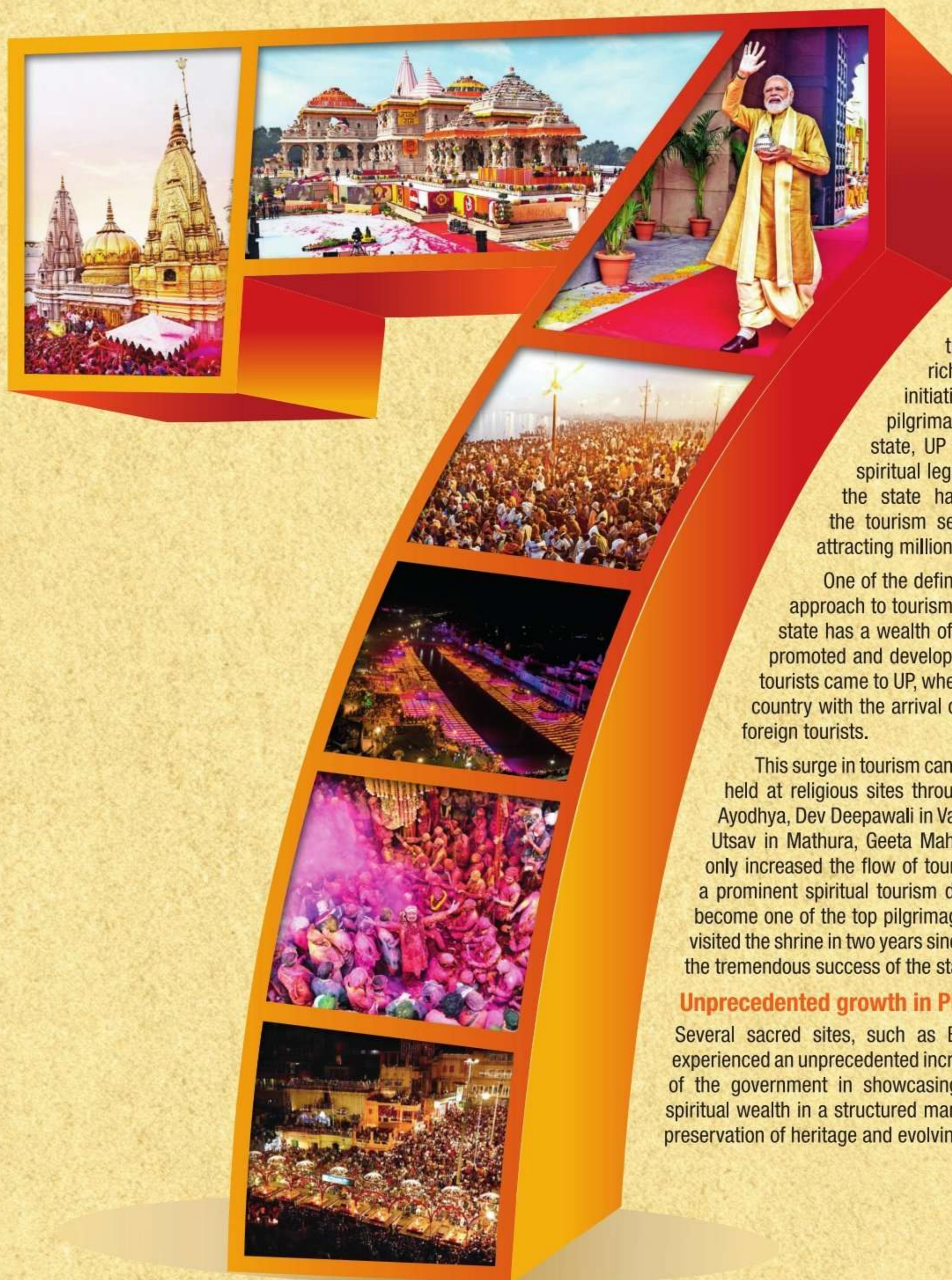

# ED searches Lalu aide's premises in Delhi, Haryana

New Delhi: Continuing its action against close associates of RJD chief and former railways minister Lalu Prasad Yadav, Enforcement Directorate on Tuesday searched 17 premises of Amit Katyal in Delhi, Gurgaon and Sonapat, alleging that the latter's real estate company has siphoned off Rs 400 crore of homebuyers' money to shell entities abroad.

Searches were carried out on properties of Haryana-based Krish Group, Krishn Buildtech Pvt Ltd, involved in real estate and liquor business controlled by Amit and Rajesh Katyal. "Katyal has allegedly sent more than Rs 200 crore of homebuyers' funds to Sri Lanka and his son, Krishan Katyal, has renounced Indian citizenship and taken the passport of St Nevis & Kitts," a senior official said.

Enforcement Directorate on Tuesday conducted searches at 17 places linked to Congress MLA from Barkagaon Amba Prasad, her relatives and associates, and circle officer Sashibhushan Singh in Jharkhand's Ranchi, Hazaribag and Ramgarh districts, reports Sanjay Sahay. Sources said cash amounting to Rs 10-12 lakh and incriminating documents had been seized in the operation.

Earlier, on Nov 11 last year, ED had arrested Amit Katyal in railways jobs-for-land scam in which Lalu Prasad Yadav, his wife Rabri Devi, three daughters and son and former Bihar deputy CM Tejashwi Yadav are accused and facing bribery and money laundering charges. This is the second successive action against a close associate of Lalu Yadav after the arrest of Subhash Yadav in Patna last week. The latter was allegedly operating a syndicate of illegal mining in Bihar, causing loss to the exchequer to the tune of Rs 160 crore.

CAA panels can take final call on citizenship. Additionally, CAA Rules, 2024 have ensured that committees at the district level and state/UT level, tasked respectively to verify documentation and take a final call on citizenship, are packed with central govt officers, even as the state/UT concerned is represented by a sole invitee to each committee.
